

Two Pianists Saturday September 16 | 7:30pm



Mission/Service/Learning Trip

On August 5-10, Pastor Emily took 24 youth, three college students, and six adults on their third mission, service, and learning trip to Dubuque, IA. During the trip, youth participated in a high/low ropes course, led Sunday worship at their host church, did conservation projects and tested the pollution levels of Catfish Creek, served a meal to homeless community members, worked in community gardens and on the St. Isidore Catholic Worker Farm, and heard from guest speakers about the intersections of faith and compassion and justice work. Additionally, they had fun exploring Dubuque, swimming, and going on a hayride at a family farm. Every night, the youth gathered together for worship and to



discuss in small groups the week's theme: "proclaiming good news" based on Luke 4:14-21.
