#### January Spotlight – Peace Not Walls!



#### **OPC Canvassing** January – February 2019

OPC (ONE People's Campaign) is a new 501(c)4 sister organization of ONE Northside, and can spend resources backing candidates for office. Since January 2018, OPC mobilized 264 volunteer shifts (typically four hours which includes 1 hour of training/debriefing and 3 hours of canvassing), knocked on 6,219 doors, had 1,137 conversations at the doors, and collected contact info for 778 new people.
